

Vacancy for Parish Councillor

One of our Parish Councillors has resigned, and we wish to co-opt someone to serve until the next scheduled elections in May 2023.

You qualify if you are a registered elector in the Parish area or if, during the twelve months before the co-option, you have owned or been a tenant of any land or premises, or if your place of work has been in the Parish area, or if you have lived within 3 miles (4.8km) of the Parish boundary. The Parish Council serves the villages of Ashby, Herringfleet and Somerleyton.

There is no upper age limit, but Councillors must be over 18 years when elected or co-opted.

Parish Councillors are all unpaid volunteers.

The Parish Council is independent and a non-political, secular, non-discriminatory body. Prospective councillors will need to be able to demonstrate their commitment to equality and diversity.

All applicants will be invited individually to an interview with the Parish Council at its Meeting on **Thursday 12th May 2022**. If you wish to be considered please send a C.V. or a letter about yourself, your experience or anything that you feel will help the Council make its decision.

Closing date: Friday 22nd April 2022.
